We recently sent out a research agenda survey to all CAN-ADAPTT members requesting feedback and assistance in prioritizing knowledge gaps for future research. Over 125 members responded. We are currently working to incorporate feedback into our draft research agenda (which will be available on the website shortly).

The top 3 prioritized areas for future research in Canada, as identified by CAN-ADAPTT members are:

1. Combination therapy
2. People making repeat attempts to quit
3. Children and Adolescents
